Find the Hidden Assumption

An **assumption** is something that you accept as being true without actually having any proof that it is true. We make many assumptions every day without necessarily realizing that we are doing so. An assumption often takes the form of an implied generalization that we don't examine very closely or at all. Identifying the hidden assumption in an idea can be a good first step to challenging that idea.
