

# Demonstratives

A demonstrative pronoun specifies something in a sentence. They can indicate something that is close or far away in distance or time.

PRONOUN	SINGULAR/PLURAL	PURPOSE
this	singular	points out something near in distance or time
that	singular	points out something far away in distance or time
these	plural	points out things near in distance or time
those	plural	points out things far away in distance or time
