Direct Objects

A **direct object** follows an *action* verb. It answers the question, "Whom?" or "What?" after the action verb.

The direct object is always a noun or a pronoun. In the example below, the action verb is underlined, and the direct object is boxed.

EXAMPLE: What did the scientists launch?

The scientists <u>launched</u> a rocket.
