

Infinitives

An infinitive is a verb form that can be used as a noun, an adjective, or an adverb. Most infinitives begin with the word "to". An infinitive can be used as:

a noun	To be prepared is our goal.
an adjective	The team to beat is the Tigers.
an adverb	This separation is hard to take.
