- \_\_\_\_\_ The setting and circumstances of the dramatic action
- \_\_\_\_\_ Using voice expressively to create meaning in the dramatic action
- \_\_\_\_\_ Using facial expression, posture and action expressively to create meaning in the dramatic action
- \_\_\_\_\_ To concentrate attention on a spatial direction or a point in space
- \_\_\_\_\_ A sense of anticipation or conflict within characters or character relationships that propel dramatic action and engage the audience
- \_\_\_\_\_ The fictional space of the dramatic action and the emotional space between characters
- \_\_\_\_\_ The fictional time in the narrative or setting and timing of the dramatic action
- \_\_\_\_\_ The expression of ideas and dramatic meaning through words
- \_\_\_\_\_ The use of something to represent something else to reinforce or extend dramatic meaning
- \_\_\_\_\_ Those who experience the arts
- \_\_\_\_\_ The feeling or tone of the physical space and the dramatic action as a result of the performance
