



Types of Conjunctions

There are three types of conjunctions.

- **Coordinating** conjunctions connect similar words together
- **Correlative** conjunctions connect similar groups of words together, but always come in pairs
- **Subordinating** conjunctions connect two ideas where one idea is more important than the other
