Three Horns

The Triceratops was a large dinosaur with a really big head and three horns. Triceratops means three-horned-face in Greek. Triceratops lived during part of the Cretaceous period about seventy million years ago in what is now the Western United States and Canada.

Today we know what Triceratops looked like and where it lived because of fossils. A fossil is any preserved remain, impression, or trace of something that was alive in a previous geological age. From the fossil record, we know that when full grown, a Triceratops weighed between seven and twelve tons. It could grow up to thirty feet long from the tip of its snout to the end of its tail and reached heights of about nine feet. Two of its long horns protruded from the forehead above their eyes, the third horn was located on its snout. Triceratops also had a hard armorlike plate called a frill covering the back side of its neck and skull which was probably used for defense against carnivores.

The Triceratops was an herbivore, which means it ate only plants. They may have used their immense size to knock down trees to reach their leaves, as elephants do today. They had many rows of teeth and a hard, sharp beak, all of which helped them to cut through and crush vegetation to eat. Paleontologists believe that Triceratops lived in herds and roamed the plains searching for food.
