

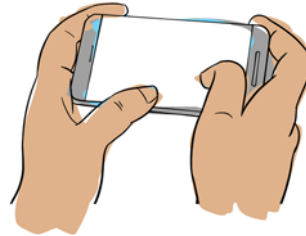
Comparative Adjectives
