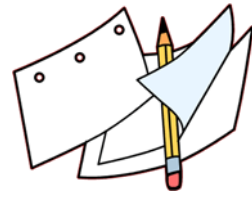


Name _____ **Is, Am, Are**



Is, Am, Are

The words *is*, *am*, and *are* are all forms of the verb **to be**. The verb *to be* can be an action verb or an auxiliary (helping) verb.

Is is the present tense, third person singular form of *to be*:

He is. She is. It is.

Am is the present tense, first person singular form of *to be*:

I am.

Are is the present tense, third person plural form of *to be*:

We are. They are
