An action verb is a word that shows action. It can be the simple predicate of the sentence. A direct object is a noun or pronoun that follows an action verb. It receives the action.



EXAMPLE: Liam <u>plays</u>. Plays is an action verb. Liam plays football. Football is the direct object.
