Direct Objects

An action verb is a word that shows action. It can be the simple predicate of the sentence. A **direct object** is a noun or pronoun that follows an action verb. It receives the action.



EXAMPLE: Liam plays. Plays is an action verb.

Liam plays football. Football is the direct object.
