Infinitives



An infinitive is a verb form that can be used as a noun, an adjective, or an adverb. Most infinitives begin with *to*.

To persevere is the greatest accomplishment. (Infinitive as a noun.)

The thing **to do** is to persevere. (Infinitive as an adjective.)

We will be required **to persevere**. (Infinitive as an adverb.)
