Gerunds + Prepositions

A gerund is the -ing form of a verb that is used as a noun. The gerund is formed by adding the suffix "-ing" to a verb. Gerunds are used as the objects of certain verbs. A gerund is sometimes combined with a verb and a preposition in the following construction: VERB + PREPOSITION + GERUND

EXAMPLES: apologize + for doing + (something) I apologize for <u>adopting</u> all these cats.
