
## **Future Perfect Tense**



The future perfect tense expresses an action that is expected to be completed sometimes in the future. Form the future perfect tense with "will" + "have" + the past participle of the verb (which can be either regular or irregular in form):

Present Tense	Future Perfect Tense
join	will have joined
conquer	will have conquered
