forms of do do, does did

forms of have have, has, had

other auxiliary verbs can, could, may, might, must, shall, should, will, would

## Tips:

- Helping verbs and main verbs can be separated by other words (Example: I do not need help.)
- Some auxiliary verbs can also be used as main verbs (Example: I am a student.)
- A auxiliary verb can become part of a contraction with a pronoun or a negative word (Example: I'm leaving this here.)
