Auxiliary Verbs

forms of be am, is, are, was, were, be, being, been

forms of do do, does did

forms of have have, has, had

other auxiliary verbs can, could, may, might, must, shall, should, will, would

Tips:

- Helping verbs and main verbs can be separated by other words (Example: *I do not need help.*)
- Some auxiliary verbs can also be used as main verbs (Example: *I am a student.*)
- A auxiliary verb can become part of a contraction with a pronoun or a negative word (Example: *I'm leaving this here.*)
