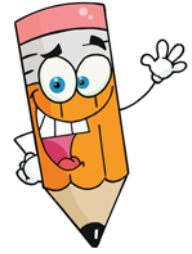

Helping Verbs



forms of be am, is, are, was, were, be, being, been

forms of do do, does did

forms of have have, has, had

other helping verbs can, could, may, might, must, shall, should, will, would

Remember:

- Helping verbs and main verbs can be separated by other words (Example: *I do not need help.*)
- Some helping verbs can also be used as main verbs (Example: *I am a student.*)
- A helping verb can become part of a contraction with a pronoun or a negative word (Example: *I'm leaving this here.*)
