Word Position in a Sentence

Words go in different positions in a sentence, depending on what kind of word it is. Nouns usually go at the beginning of a sentence. Adjectives usually go before nouns. Nouns and adjectives both sometimes go after verbs. The position of a word in a sentence depends on its function.
