## Cinco de Mayo



Cinco de Mayo, which means May 5<sup>th</sup> in Spanish, marks the anniversary of Mexico's most famous military victory, which took place on the morning of May 5th, 1862. French, Spanish, and English troops landed in Mexico to collect debts from President Benito Juarez.
