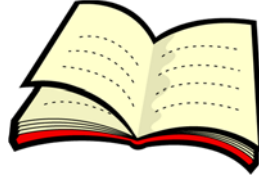


Subtext

1. The word subtext literally means "under the text."

2. Subtext refers to something that is explicitly stated by the author.

3. In literature, subtext only conveys and/or reinforces thematic information.

4. Writers use subtext both to convey additional information to readers and to further engage them, as understanding subtext requires active participation on the part of a reader.

5. Subtext can be defined as what you "read between the lines."

6. All fiction includes subtext.

7. Subtext occurs only in fiction.

8. Subtext can provide information about characters, plot, and the whole context of a story.

9. Subtext can communicate information about how a character feels.
