**Who was he:** First president of the United States

**Key Events/Roles:** Led the Virginia Militia in the French and Indian War; one of Virginia's delegates at the First and Second Continental Congress; General of the Continental Army; helped to draft the U.S. Constitution in 1787; first president of the United States

**Childhood:** George Washington was the son of a landowner and planter in Colonial Virginia. His father died when Washington was eleven years old, and he was raised by his older brother Lawrence. Washington learned to read and how to do math, and at the age of sixteen, he began working for a surveyor, measuring and mapping lands.
