

Presenting Quotations as Evidence

There are three ways to embed quotations:

- When you set-off a quotation, distinguish it from the rest of the sentence with a comma and capitalize the first word of the quote. Use a signal phrase when setting off a quotation.
- Build a quote into a sentence. Introduce a built-in quote with a signal phrase and the word "that." The first word of the quote is NOT capitalized.
- Introduce a quote with a colon. The preceding sentence signals that what comes after the colon is a quotation by providing some information about it. Capitalize the first word in the quote.
