Lettuce is both inexpensive and easy to grow. A packet of seeds costs less than a single head of lettuce from the grocery store and can be found in the early spring in any store that sells garden supplies. Lettuce does not take up much space and can even be grown in a pot. To plant lettuce, simply make grooves in the soil with your fingers, sprinkle in the seeds, cover them over with a thin layer of the soil, and pat it down. Give your lettuce a little water, and water it whenever the soil looks dry. Within a month, you'll be enjoying your own lettuce for a fraction of what it would cost you to buy it.
