

## **Possessive Nouns**

Possessive nouns show that something belongs to a person, place, thing or idea. To make a singular noun possessive, add an apostrophe and an "s" to the end.

**EXAMPLE**: The pencil belongs to lan.Ian's pencilThe pen belongs to Ann.Anna's pen

If the noun already ends in "s", just add an apostrophe to the end.

**EXAMPLE**: The dog belons to Willis. This box belongs to the girls. Willis' dog the girls' box
