Title	A main heading that gives the reader clues what the text is about.
Table of Contents	A list at the front of a text that tells you the names of the chapter, headings, and subheadings in the text and what page they are on.
Index	A list of words and/or phrases from the text with page numbers beside them, so readers can find these things in the text.
Glossary	A list of words used in the text and their definitions.
Headings	Titles for sections within a text that help organize the information by breaking it into smaller sections.
Sidebars	Smaller bits of additional or supplemental information located outside of the main text.
Pictures	Illustrations of things mentioned in the text.
Captions	Brief descriptions located underneath the pictures in a text.
Diagrams	Visual representations of concepts.

Graphs	Numerical representations of data presented in visual form.
Maps	A visual representation of how places are related or connected with one another.
Cutaways and Cross Sections	Drawings that show readers how things are structured or what they are made of.
