

Subject Pronouns

A subject pronoun takes the place of a noun in each sentence, usually after it has already been introduced.

Person	Singular Subject Pronouns	Plural Subject Pronouns
1st (speaking)	I	We
2nd (being spoken to)	You	You
3rd (being spoken about)	He/She/It	They
