

Cause and Effect Thesis

The **cause-and-effect essay** is an argumentative essay that makes a case for relationships between two subjects. Typically, the author will show how a person, thing, idea, or event influenced another person, thing, idea or event.

There are several ways to approach the thesis for a cause and effect essay:

- Focus on a single cause-and-effect relationship
- Show how one event causes multiple effects
- Explore how a single phenomenon has multiple causes
