 Belief in a strong organized government
 Spread throughout much of India and China
 Belief that people should be one with nature and that all living things have a universal force flowing through them
Belief in karma, that all actions have consequences and a person has to deal with the consequences of how they act
Focuses on treating others with respect, politeness, and fairness
 Introduced the concepts of Yin and Yang
 Honor and morality are the highest qualities
 Honoring one's relatives was required
Well-known today for its many sayings
Did not believe in a lot of rules or government
Belief in a "rebirth" of the self
Belief that the cycle of rebirth is complete once a person lives a proper life
