The culture and government of the Akkadian Empire was very different from that of the

2. Sumerians.

The Akkadians and the Sumerians spoke the

3. same language.

While the Sumerians remained a civilization of warring city-states, the Akkadian city-states

4. began to form alliances.

Sargon the Great founded a city which he

- 5. named Akkad.
- 6. Akkad attacked the Sumerian city of Uruk and won.

Sargon the Great was the first leader of the

7. Akkadian Empire.

Naram-Sin, the grandson of Sargon the Great,

8. was the last leader of the Akkadian Empire.

When the Akkadian Empire fell, it was under the

9. rule of a Sumerian king.
