The First Continental Congress	The First Continental Congress, held in 1774, was Ben Franklin's idea. He delivered the colonies' petition to King George III of England.
The Second Continental Congress	He was the Pennsylvania delegate to the Second Continental Congress.
Declaration of Independence	He was part of the committee that wrote the Declaration of Independence.
French support for the American Revolution	Franklin went to France for several years in 1776, where he gathered French support for the American Revolution.
The Treaty of Paris	Franklin remained in France during the American Revolution, and in 1783, he helped to negotiate the end of the war with the Treaty of Paris.
