Positioning Nouns in a Sentence

Words go in different positions in a sentence, depending on what kind of word it is. Nouns usually go at the beginning of a sentence, but nouns sometimes go after verbs. The position of a word in a sentence depends on its function. Nouns which are the subject of the sentence go in the beginning of the sentence. Nouns which function as direct objects go after the verb.
