Lockwood 1 st person	Lockwood gives his perspective on people, places, and events in real time as he encounters them. He also reports what he hears from Nelly.	He is unreliable because his perspective is arrogant and self-absorbed. He also reports that he repeats what Nelly says "only a little condensed," so what he reports may not be entirely accurate.
Ellen "Nelly" Dean 1 st person	Nelly recalls her memories of the past.	She is unreliable because she has strong emotional attachments to the people she is talking about, so she may not be objective about them.
