Charts for Infographics

In infographic is a visual representation of information or data. infographics are very useful because they can convey a lot of information very quickly in a way that is easy to understand. Infographics typically use a combination of text, images, graphs, and/or charts. Read about some basic graphs and charts. A bar or column chart shows values by the length of bars. The longer the bars, the greater the value. A bar chart is a good way to compare values to each other. This kind of chart can be either vertical or horizontal, and usually requires labels for the bars or columns.



A line chart shows how a value changes over time across something that is continuously measured. When the change is positive, the line goes up. When the change is negative, the line goes down. A line chart is great for showing a trend.



A pie chart shows how parts of a whole are distributed. If you have an amount of time or money, for example, and you want to show how it is broken down into parts, a pie chart is a great way to make the concept visual.
