Uncertainty with Adverbs

Many words and phrases act like markers in a text to indicate to readers that the author is less than certain about what is being said. Collectively, these words and phrases that indicate uncertainty are called **uncertainty** qualifiers. One category of uncertainty qualifiers are adverbs. For example:



roughly	somewhat	mostly	essentially	especially
exceptionally	often	almost	practically	actually
