An object pronoun takes the place of a person or thing that is acted upon or that receives the action of the verb in the sentence.

Person	Object Pronouns - Singular	Object Pronouns - Plural
1st (speaking)	me	us
2nd (being spoken to)	you	you
3rd (being spoken about)	him/her/it	them
