



# Creating a Complicating Subplot

A story with multiple plot lines typically has one main plot, and at least one subplot. A subplot is a supporting side story that deepens or enhances the reader's experience of the main story in some way. One type of subplot further complicates the main plot. In a **complicating subplot**, a secondary character with their own story goal makes things harder for the protagonist in the main story.
