Also Known As	Battle of the Ardennes
Dates	December 16, 1944 — January 16, 1945
Locations	Ardennes, Belgium, Meuse River
Participants	United States, Germany, Britain
Which War?	World War II
How it got its name	The battle got its name because as the Germans attacked, they pushed into the center of the Allied forces' line. If you had an aerial view of the battle, you would see a bulge at the point of attack.
Outcome	The Allies lost about 75,000 casualties, but Germany lost 120,000 troops and much matériel. It could no longer resist the Allied offensive when it resumed. This was a turning point for Germany, who no longer believed they would be able to defeat the Allies.
