Logos

Logos is a Greek word with a variety of related meanings: "ground", "plea", "opinion", "expectation", "word", "speech", "account", "reason", "proportion", and "discourse". As a rhetorical device, logos is an appeal to logic and rationality. Using logos in an argument means appealing to the other person's sense of reason, for example, by providing statistics, facts, data, charts, and graphs are all ways of using logos.
