

# Transitions for Time/Sequence

Transition words are used in a sentence to connect two ideas. They join clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or entire sections of writing together to show a relationship between them. Different transition words signal different kinds of relationships. One kind of relationship that transition words can signal between ideas is time/sequence. For example:

| from time to time | in the meantime | first, second, etc. |
| later             | before          | after               |
| henceforth        | during          | by the time         |
| until now         | occasionally    | sometimes           |
