Amidst may be noted as an obsolete form of amid. It is more common in British English than in American English.

Amongst may be an obsolete form of among. It is more common in British English than in American English. Among/amongst is sometimes used interchangeably and incorrectly with between.

Fortuitously is sometimes used interchangeably with fortunately, but the concept of fortuitousness is merely a reference to an occurrence depending on chance, and not necessarily a good (i.e., fortunate) chance occurrence.
