



Present Subjunctive

The **subjunctive mood** is a verb form which expresses a wish, a suggestion, a hope, a command, or an imaginary situation. Form the present subjunctive with the base form of a verb followed by the word "that." You find the subjunctive mood following nouns, verbs, or adjectives that make suggestions, commands, or requests.

- Suggestions: I recommend that you take the SAT.
- Commands: I demand that you refund my money.
- Requests: I prefer that you turn down your music.

Add "not" before the subjunctive verb to make it negative.
