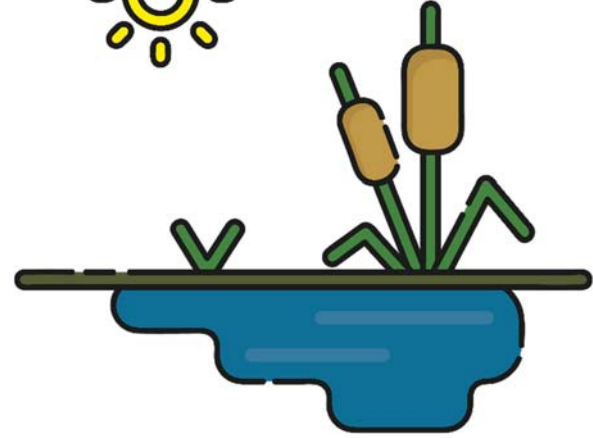

Grade 7 Subtraction Word Problems

1. A reservoir initially held 2,150,000 gallons of water. After a week of drought, it was left with 2,067,200 gallons. How much water was lost during this week?
2. A YouTube channel had 1,356,000 subscribers. However, after a controversial video was uploaded, they lost some subscribers and dropped to 1,287,730. How many subscribers did the channel lose?
3. The local zoo had 1,234 animals at the start of the year. Over the course of the year, 47 animals were moved to other zoos, and 189 new animals arrived. How many animals does the zoo have now?
4. A mountain's height was measured at 24,000 feet in 1990. Erosion over time reduced the height to 23,965 feet by 2023. How many feet did the mountain lose due to erosion?
5. The school started the year with 7,000 textbooks. Throughout the year, 220 were lost or damaged beyond repair, but 150 new books were bought. How many textbooks are there now?
6. A soccer team scored 60 goals in a season. The goalkeeper conceded 32 goals. What is the team's goal difference?
7. A bakery baked 750 muffins in the morning. By the end of the day, they had 135 muffins left. How many muffins were sold throughout the day?
8. A parking lot has a capacity of 200 cars. Currently, there are 145 cars parked in the lot. How many more cars can the parking lot accommodate?
9. An author has written 17 books. They decided to remove 3 books from their portfolio. How many books remain in their portfolio?
10. The local amusement park sold 5,300 tickets for a special event. However, only 4,957 guests attended. How many guests didn't show up?
