Only eat cold food.

- $\sqrt{}$ Change batteries in smoke detectors every six months.
- $\sqrt{1}$ Install smoke detectors on every level of your home.
- $\sqrt{}$ Make a family fire escape plan.
- $\sqrt{}$ Have family fire drills.
