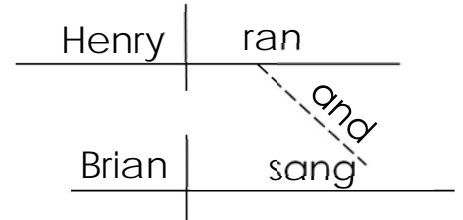


Simple Compound Sentences
