Dystopia

though the society may seem ideal on the surface, it is ultimately undesirable, frightening, or dehumanizing

an intrinsically human value is missing

the story includes the protagonist's discovery that their society is not what it seems to be

the society is usually isolated or contained in some way; there is an other place where things are different

usually grounded in "reality" without elements of fantasy

Both Dystopia and Science Fiction

both can reveal the fears and anxieties of a culture

Science Fiction

based in science

scientific facts, theories, and principles underlie its characters, plots, and settings

story lines and elements are plausible and theoretically possible

usually set in the future

anything is possible – can contain elements of fantasy

the world is not necessarily better or worse than today, it is just different
