A bias is an opinion that is overly in favor of or against something in a way that is prejudiced, close-minded, or unfair.

Prejudice is a preconceived opinion or feeling about a person that is based on their belonging to a certain ethnic group, religion, or organization.

Discrimination is taking certain actions that are based on feelings of prejudice. Like bias, discrimination can be positive, for example, offering discounts to veterans. A veteran discount is treating veterans differently based on their affiliation with the military.
