1. A cliffhanger is a storytelling technique that means leaving characters in a difficult and unresolved situation at the end of a story, chapter, or episode.
2. a state or feeling of excited or anxious uncertainty about what may happen
3. A cliffhanger is a plot device designed to create suspense in the story.
4. A story with suspense includes cliffhangers where suspense is intentionally created at the end of a section or chapter by leaving a difficult, dangerous, or surprising situation unresolved. Not all suspenseful stories necessarily include cliffhangers, but suspense is an integral part of the cliffhanger, so all stories with cliffhangers include suspense.
