1. A caesura is a break or pause in the middle of a line of verse (including in song lyrics).

3. A caesura is a place to take a breath between phrases while keeping the line sounding natural. It can also provide a dramatic pause.
4. When the rhythm or meaning of one line of poetry runs down into the next line.
5. Caesura and enjambment are almost like opposites; with a caesura, the reader is expected to pause within a line; with enjambment, the reader is expected to NOT pause at the end of the line, but to keep reading into the next line before pausing.
