1. A doppelganger is the double of a character.
2. The term comes from a German word that means "look-alike," or "double walker."
3. In literature, a doppelganger is usually the twin of the protagonist. They may or may not have the same name. Several examples of a doppelganger include an evil twin, a person's past or future self, a simple look-alike.
4. Originally, a doppelganger referred to a ghost or shadow of a person. Today, the term is used to refer to someone that is a look-alike of another person.
