



ANSWERS

1. Both involve more than one identity; however, an alter ego is a second self of the same individual, which is believed to be distinct from a person's original, normal, or true personality, and the two sides do not necessarily obviously resemble each other physically. A doppelganger is TWO people.
2. Mind control means a character is being controlled by someone else. This is not a doppelganger because it is still only one person, and a doppelganger must be a different character that is a mirror image of the main character in some way.
3. An imposter is someone who dresses like the character and pretends to be them. This is not a doppelganger, because though it is two people, the doppelganger is a mirror image of the character in some way, not just someone pretending to be them; it IS them.
